Place the paper at an angle. If you are right-handed, make sure the top right and bottom left corners of your paper line up straight with your nose. Use your left arm to hold the paper still. If you are left-handed, the top left and bottom right corners should line up with your nose, with your right arm keeping the paper secure.

How Cursive Writing Uniquely Helps Brain Development

To straighten up a bit, adjust the angle of the paper. Think of your writing space as a clock, with 12 o'clock straight ahead. If you're right-handed, rotate the page so that the bottom-right corner is at 4 o'clock and the top-left one is at 10 o'clock. For lefties, the bottom-left corner should fall at 8 and the upper-right corner at 2.
