In DDO, clerics rely on Concentration when casting spells, and when taking damage from enemy attacks. When a cleric is damaged while casting a Concentration check occurs - failure results in Spell Points (SP) being wasted while the spell fizzles out.

Clerics already have the best Radiant damage spells in the game, and the Light domain supplements those spells with some of the best Fire damage spells. If your party doesn't have room for both a Cleric and a Wizard, the Light domain is a good choice because you can so easily replace the Wizard's ability to quickly handle groups of weak enemies.

You learn additional Cleric Cantrips of your choice at higher levels, as shown in the Cantrips Known column of the Cleric table.
