They should be 0.69 in (4.20 cm) deep, about 1 in (2.5 cm) apart, in rows 6 in (15 cm) apart. Cover the seeds gently with soil after planting. You can also plant radishes in between the rows to improve the harvest and break the soil for the carrots.

Direct sow seeds in well drained soil in full sun after danger of frost. Baby's Breath can tolerate a pH of 6.5 to 7.5.
