The first line of each reference should be flush left with the margin of the page. Each subsequent line of your reference should be indented. Use the DOI. If a digital object identifier (DOI) is available, include it at the end of the reference.

Book - A written work or composition that has been published - typically printed on pages bound together. Book citations in APA contain the author name, publication year, book title, publication title, and publisher name. Citing a book in print

Book - A written work or composition that has been published - typically printed on pages bound together. Book citations in MLA 7 style generally contain the author name, book title, publication city, publisher, year published, and the medium of the work (i.e. "Print" for print books). Note: When you list the pages of the chapter or essay in parentheses after the book title, use "pp." before the numbers: (pp. 1-21). This abbreviation, however, does not appear before the page numbers in periodical references. List any edition number in the same set of parentheses as the page numbers, separated by a comma: (2nd ed., pp. 66-72).

Title the page 'References' Place 'References' in the center of the page and bold it. Keep the title in the same font and size as the references. Do not italicize, underline, place the title in quotation marks, or increase the font size.

Start with the author. Your citation of a book in your reference list typically begins with the last name of the author of the book. After the last name, place a comma, and then type the first and middle initials of the author. Example: "Doe, J. H."

Abbreviate 'edition' to 'edn' or 'revised edition' to 'rev ed'. When referencing a book published in multiple volumes, include the total number of volumes in your reference.
