When a hue is “toned,” both white and black (grey) are added to the color to reduce the color’s saturation. When a color has high saturation, the pigment intensity is vivid and bright. When a

HSV Color Scale: The HSV (which stands for Hue Saturation Value) scale provides a numerical readout of your image that corresponds to the color names contained therein. HUE, VALUE, SATURATION

The saturation of a color is its degree of richness, intensity, purity, or grayness. Other commonly used terms for saturation are intensity or chroma. For example, cadmium orange and burnt sienna are the same hue (orange), but cadmium orange has a high saturation whereas burnt sienna has a low saturation.

Once your cursor turns into an Eyedropper, you can click on one point in the image and it will target just that exact color. You can also click and drag the grey slider that appears between the two colored bars. Colorizing. Create a new Hue/Saturation layer and check the "Colorize" button. This will change the entire image to the same Color!

If Hue is Red, and saturation is 100% then it is a different color then if Hue is Red and saturation is let's say 60%/99%/01% etc, so for the value. There is Dark Red, and so there is Light Red. As things lose Saturation, their 'lightness' is converted from color to equivalent gray/white 'lightness'.

This adjustment is especially good for fine-tuning colors in a CMYK image so that they are in the gamut of an output device. Apply a Hue/Saturation adjustment Add an adjustment layer.

First move the Hue slider to the color band you want (if the Value and Saturation sliders are set to low values, you don't see an immediate result in the swatch). Move the Value slider to set the brightness, or intensity of the color. Move the Saturation slider to determine the purity of the color.

Color saturation is a powerful tool for drawing attention to your focal point.

For one color of specific hue the perception of brightness is also more intense, if we increase saturation. A higher level of saturation makes a color look brighter. In relation to other colors the brightness intensity of a color is also influenced by its hue.
