In this interaction, an incident x-ray photon enters a tissue atom, interacts with an orbital electron (generally a middle- or outer-shell electron), and removes it from its shell. In doing so, the incident photon loses up to one third of its energy and is usually deflected in a new direction (Figure 7-3).

Although a large number of possible interactions are known, there are three key interaction mechanisms with matter. The strength of these interactions depends on the energy of the X-rays and the elemental composition of the material, but not much on chemical properties, since the X-ray photon energy is much higher than chemical binding energies.
